This was the first trip outside of Cuba for each of them. They spent a four weeks in July and early August in the United Kingdom including three weeks at The Prince's Foundation Summer School for Architects and Builders. There were 25 participants in the Summer School and they came from nine countries. One week was spent in London followed by two weeks in Scotland based at the historic estate of Dumfries House. They traveled while in Scotland to both Edinburgh and Glasgow, and they spent an additional seven days for exploration of London and the rich cultural scene of museums and architecture.


